- tion next higher than Proposal #22 places the school, for the time remaining in the four-year cycle as provided in Article II, Rule 7, page 17.
3. A school may move from a lower to a higher classification by mak-

ing a written request to the AAA office before January 1, in the school year in which the change is to become effective and provided further the school has received the approval of two-thirds of the schools involved. Any change allowed shall become effective when the above provisions are met and shall remain for a minimum of four

- years.
4. A school shall be permitted to change for one conference to another by two-thirds majority vote of the involved schools of each conference.
5. All polling done in accordance with the above items three and four must be administered by the AAA office.
